What is happening on September 4?

Life Church will begin holding their services in the Auditorium, so we will share the Community Center during the same time-frame of 8:00 a.m to 12:00 p.m.

How will this affect our Sunday mornings at C3?

While this will be a change for us, Life Church has been willing to work around our schedule. They will stagger their two services so there will be minimal overlap.

- Our schedule will remain the same with set-up starting at 8:00 and Talk Back ending at 12:00.
- Their first service will be 9:30-10:45, and the second will be 11:00-12:15. Both services will start with 20 minutes of music. Their children's program will stay in their current facility.

How will visitors know where to go?

We will have signs inside and outside of the building, as well as hosts in the hallway so people who want to attend C3 are welcomed and know how to join the Gathering.

Will we lose our space in the Community Center?

No. We still rent the Mackinaw Room, as well as the Woodbine and Suite rooms, so our PreTalk, Meditation, Gathering, Children's Program, and Talk Back will take place as usual. We have been offered a five-year "Memorandum of Understanding" that guarantees we can stay for five years, while also giving us the freedom to move if we eventually find another location that suits our needs better.

Why is this happening?

Two reasons are driving this change:

1. Life Church has outgrown its current venue and plans to build a new, larger facility; this is temporary until then.
2. The Community Center said "yes" to their request to rent because of a need for recurring revenue so it can continue to serve the community. They will be launching a rebranding campaign in October. It includes a new name, website, and equipping the hallway with a coffee kiosk, furniture, and art gallery. They plan to rent more of the building as often as possible.

This is a big change. What can I do during this transition?

- First, recognize this is an opportunity to live our values. Be good, welcoming neighbors. Remember, this is a big change for Life Church, too.
- Invite your friends and family and encourage C3ers who watch at home to show up in person on Sunday mornings to add their support and make C3 a strong presence.
